



**G29 Council and Committee Dates 2009**

The list of Council and Committee meetings had been received. A request for an extra planning meeting, should it be necessary, was added prior to the Christmas break and a suggestion that an extra planning meeting might be required when the ASM application was received.

**RESOLVED that the dates be adopted.**

**G30 S106 Agreements**

The Town Clerk gave an overview on the presentation given by Sullina Tullack at the Council meeting held on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008 which identified outstanding S106 agreement monies and their designated usage. A Community Infrastructure Levy to replace S106 agreements would be introduced in 2009 based on the uplift of development land. It was suggested that the Council should form a working party to identify use of these funds. A future town plan would help with the process. Assets currently owned by EDDC, which could transfer to the Town Council dependant on the boundary commission recommendations.

**RECOMMENDED that a working party be appointed to**

- (a) consider the use of outstanding S106 agreement funds and consider proposed Community Infrastructure Levy issues;**
- (b) work on a future Town Plan**
- (c) look at current property and services currently owned by EDDC with a view to transfer to Exmouth Town Council**

**G31 Cycle Track Extension on the Esplanade**

Cllr D Nicholas reported that complaints had been received as to the safety to pedestrians, particularly the elderly and disabled, of the newly created cycle track extension on the Esplanade. Questions were raised as to the cost of the project, lack of consultation with the Town Council and whether any remedial works would take place as a result of danger to users.

**RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be requested to write to Devon County Council reporting the concerns received from members of the public raising the questions asked.**

**G32 Allotments**

A letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> August 2008 from the Exmouth and District Allotments Association was put before the committee requesting a change of dates for the lighting of bonfire to burn old vegetation to be changed from 1<sup>st</sup> November – 31<sup>st</sup> March to the 1<sup>st</sup> October – 28<sup>th</sup> February.

**RESOLVED that the new dates be adopted.**
