Keeping You Informed

Regular information bulletins are being issued to keep local businesses up to date with the Strand Enhancement.

The works will inevitably cause some disruption but every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience to businesses, shoppers and visitors. Pedestrian access will be maintained to premises at all times they are open for business. You will be contacted by site staff before works are carried out that directly affect your frontage.

Key Actions

Arcadia Garage to Powder Monkey

Works will continue with installing new underground drainage pipes, slot channels and granite kerbs. Due to the number of underground services and the poor state of the existing drainage this work is taking longer than planned.

Rolle Street, between Devon Air Ambulance and Cinema

Works have started on excavation of the existing kerb line and installing slot drains and underground ducts for BT. Next week (week beginning 19th April) works will start on the new granite kerbing and granite paving slabs.

South end of Strand between Garners and The Clipper

Works will start during week beginning 19th April on drainage and underground ducting.
